Dear Parishioners,

Date for my operation. Earlier this week I received a letter from UHCW (Walsgrave Hospital) to go in for my heart bypass surgery on Monday 28th May and the operation may well be the next day (29th.) I expect to be in hospital for about a week or so and then I will need a good four or five weeks after I leave hospital to recuperate during which time I will not be available. I will put more practical details in next week's newsletter, but may I thank you for all the prayers and cards. I would like to thank in advance the priests and deacons of the deanery who have so generously offered to keep things going during my time in hospital and recuperation period afterwards.
