As today's gospel tells us of the call of the disciples, the late Cardinal Carlo Martini has this lovely reflection:

*The disciple must be united to Jesus as the branch is to the vine. He must live in Jesus, meaning he must inhabit Jesus' spiritual world, and must make his own the motivations and the profound origins of Jesus; love. For this reason he has to live with Jesus in the Father and in the love uniting Father and Son. Living in the Father and the Son by the power of the Spirit, the disciple himself becomes a dwelling, a temple, the habitation of the Father and the Son.*

*The dwelling of all believers in the unique mystery of the love of God revealed by Jesus becomes the basis of a very profound communion of believers among themselves...And unity among believers becomes such a vivid*

*testimony of the love between the Father and the Son that it attracts the world to faith in the mission Jesus has received from His Father.*
